



Patricia Ruth Story

February 9, 1943 - January 11, 2017

Funeral services for Patricia Story, 73, of Lexington, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 14, 2017 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will follow in the St. James Lutheran Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, January 13, 2017 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Lexington. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Patricia Ruth Story was born on February 9, 1943 in Lexington, Texas, the daughter of Charlie Melvin Story and Gladys Bernice (Richter) Story. She was baptized on March 1, 1953 and confirmed on April 14, 1957 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington by Rev. Paul Stengel. Her confirmation verse was Romans 5:1, "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." Patricia graduated from Lexington High School in 1961 and attended Durham Business College. She worked at W.H. Richardson in Austin for over 20 years and retired from the Texas Department of Public Safety. She was a longtime member of Grace Lutheran Church in Elgin and was currently a member of St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington where she had been involved in the Ladies Aid. Patricia was also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 6 in Lexington. She enjoyed reading and spoiling children.

Patricia passed away the evening of Wednesday, January 11, 2017 at the Bastrop Lost Pines Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Patricia was preceded in death by her parents, Melvin & Gladys Story.

She is survived by her three sisters, Betty Durkin of Lexington, Kathy Stifflemire & her husband, James of Lexington, and Connie Ward & her husband, Jerry of Lexington. Patricia is also survived by several nieces, nephews and cousins.
