



## Paul H. Heintze

Paul was born September 4, 1934 in Sharp Texas, and was the son of Albert and Mary Heintze. He was a lifelong resident of Milam County. Paul was a 1952 graduate of Sharp High School, and on March 3, 1956 he and Gloria Stephens were married at the Murray Street Church of Christ. He worked thirty five years for TXU and five years for Alcoa before retiring in 1995. Paul was the past president of the Rockdale Little League Baseball program serving as a coach for over ten years, and was instrumental in acquiring the property and moving little league to its present location. Paul was an avid Rockdale Tiger supporter serving as the Athletic Booster Vice President and President during the Head Coach Fred Johnson's era. After retirement, he continued to farm and ranch. He enjoyed nurturing his garden, cooking chili, barbequing, playing dominoes, fishing, and going to school sporting events to watch his children and later grandchildren.

Paul passed away on Monday, February 25, 2019 in the Baylor Scott & White Hospital Temple, TX. He was 84 years old. He was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Gloria. Paul was the youngest of 10 children. He was

preceded in death by his parents, seven sisters, and one brother.
