Paula Laura (Eschberger) Jatzlau was born on December 12, 1925 in Manheim, Texas to William Charles and Lydia Marie (Faske) Eschberger. She was baptized on December 20, 1925 by Rev. C.W. Rische and was confirmed on April 2, 1939 by Rev. E.J. Riske, both at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas. Her confirmation verse was Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek". Paula was married to Arthur Clarence Jatzlau on October 12, 1944, also at Ebenezer Lutheran Church, by Rev. Paul Brust. They were married for 70 years until Arthur's death in October of 2014. She enjoyed crocheting, gardening, cooking and farming and ranching with Arthur. Paula passed away on Friday morning, September 25, 2015 in Serbin, Texas.

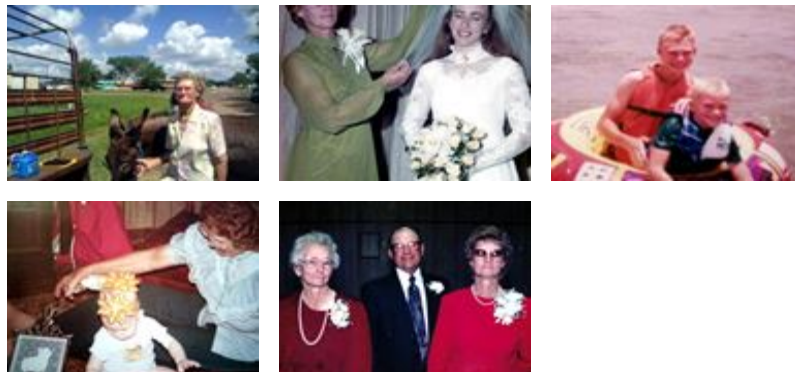
