Paula Frances (Massengale) Weiser was born on September 8, 1947 in Freeport, Texas, the daughter of Alfred Paul "A.P." Massengale and Wilma Frances (Jennings) Massengale. She was baptized on March 29, 1959 at Velasco Methodist Church and confirmed on January 8, 1978 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Emil Krugler. Paula graduated from Freeport High School in 1965, received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Education from Sam Houston State University in 1970 and her Master of Education degree in 1974 also from Sam Houston State University. Paula was united in marriage to Alton James Weiser on July 9, 1977 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Emil Krugler. She started her career in education as a teacher and then a special education teacher with the Alvin ISD. She began working as a special education teacher with Giddings ISD in 1977. She later became an educational diagnostician and served as Special Education Director for Giddings ISD. Paula finally retired in 2005. Paula was a member

of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, the Lee County Retired Teachers Association and the Texas Retired Teachers Association. She enjoyed raising her children and being involved in all of their activities while they were growing up. Her grandkids were her joy and she cherished every moment she was able to spend with them. She also liked to watch Antique Roadshow and loved working on family genealogy. She enjoyed outings and spending time with her friend, Tricia Krugler, whom she thought of as her adopted sister. Paula passed away during the early morning hours of Thursday, September 1, 2016 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin.

She was preceded in death by her parents, A.P. & Wilma Massengale.

But Here it starts a new*

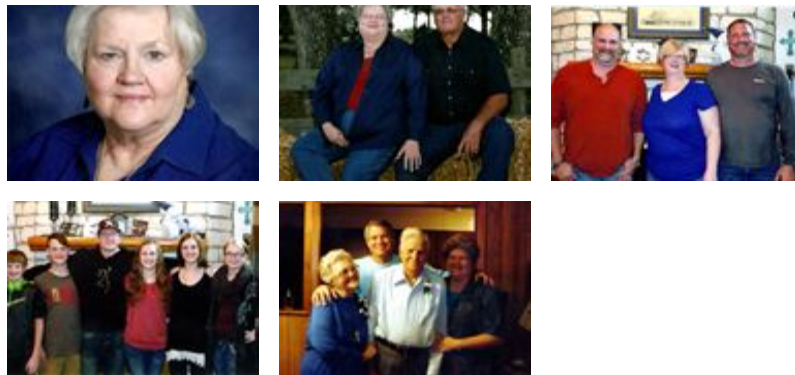
*I promise no tomorrow
