Funeral services for Pearl Richardson, 75 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, November 14, 2016 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner and Rev. Chris Nietubicz officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Lillian Pearl Richardson was born on April 14, 1941 in Schattel, Texas, the daughter of Otto Melcher and Ella (Symmank) Melcher. She was baptized on May 5, 1941 and confirmed on April 3, 1955. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 145:18-19, "The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. He fulfills the desires of those who fear him; he hears their cry and saves them". Pearl married Walter Richardson and they had two children together, Kimberly and Stanley. Later in her life, she met her "sweetheart", Joe Hanson. They enjoyed life together for many years until his passing in 2010. She worked at the Giddings State School for 23 years starting out as a houseparent and retiring from security. Pearl's family always came first in her life and she cherished and made the most of every moment they had together. Family gatherings were always brighter with Pearl and they were never complete without her fried chicken and noodles. She loved taking care of her

cats, fishing and visiting with her longtime friends whenever and wherever they met.

Pearl passed away unexpectedly the afternoon of Wednesday, November 9, 2016 in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Otto & Ella Melcher; her companion in life, Joe Hanson; her granddaughter, Lindsey Richardson; her brother, Everett "Sonny" Melcher; her brother-in-law, Fred O Placke and the father of their children, Walter Richardson.
