She was baptized early on in the Baptist faith. With her stepdad, Lealand Caldwell, being in the military, they were blessed to travel and be stationed in numerous areas. Peggy had four children, Tanya, Howard, Sherrie, and George. She was a very talented woman and was well known for being a singer and her work in the music industry. Proverbs 31 "Many women do noble things, but you surpass them all" is one of the best ways to describe Peggy's devotion to her family and community. She was a volunteer at the Sunshine House in Lexington for many years. She went to garage sales as often as possible to search for items for shut in families around the community. At one point in the 1970's, Peggy even wrote a book called Satan's Revenge. She enjoyed crocheting, sewing, oil painting, going on cruises and playing nickel slots.

Peggy passed away the afternoon of Sunday, February 4, 2024 at Sterling Oaks Rehabilitation.

She is preceded in death by father, Roy Rogers; her mother, Lucille Caldwell; step father, Lealand Caldwell; brother, Buddy Caldwell, and her great niece, Cloey Caldwell.

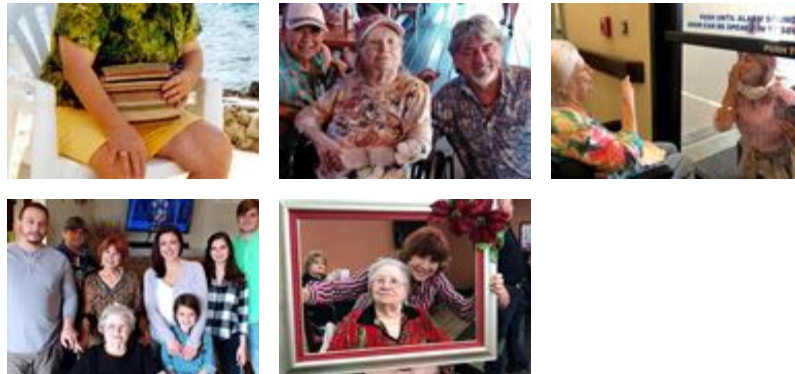
