Pete Walker, Jr., age 71 of Rockdale formerly of Georgetown passed away Friday, August 28, 2020 in the V.A. Hospital in Temple.

Pete Walker, Jr. was born November 23, 1948 in Brownsville, Texas to Pete, Sr. and Doris June (Davis) Walker. While growing up in Brownsville he attended Ebony Heights Elementary Stell Jr. High and graduated from Brownsville High School Class of 1967. He then graduated from Durham Welding School in Brownsville. He served in the U.S. Army from 1967 to 1970 attaining the rank of Sergeant while serving as a paratrooper with the Special Forces. He became a self-employed welder for 40 plus years. Pete earned his black belt and was a karate instructor. He was a member of Crossroads Bible Church in Rockdale. On February 17, 2008, he and Christine Duke were married in Georgetown.

Pete is preceded in death by his parents, Pete, Sr. and Doris June Walker.
