Quincy A. Berka, 97, a longtime resident of Caldwell, Texas, passed away on Wednesday, October 29, 2025, at Burleson Manor.

A visitation will be held on Monday, November 3, 2025, at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell. A graveside funeral service will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at New Tabor Cemetery in Caldwell, Texas.

Quincy was born on December 25, 1927, in Rockdale, Texas, to Franklin J. Berka and Rosie Vavra Berka. He grew up in Caldwell and married Ruthie Jo Roundtree in 1956. Their union was blessed with four children: Donald, Jay, Karen, and Dianna. Quincy later had another son, Wyatt Berka, with his then-wife Jeanette.

Quincy is a World War II vet and a proud member of the Caldwell VFW post 4458. Quincy served as an airplane mechanic in the U.S. Army. After completing his tour of duty, he continued working as an airplane mechanic in Bryan, Texas. He spent the majority of his remaining working years as a self-employed auto mechanic, known for his ability to fix, build, or fabricate anything he set his mind to.

Quincy had a deep love for music and was a talented musician. He often said,

"If the instrument has strings, I can play it." He was a well-known lead and rhythm guitar player and singer for various country and western bands in the area. One of his favorite venues in his younger years was the Gold Star in Caldwell.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Franklin J. Berka and Rosie Vavra Berka; three sisters: Norma Doty, Zelma Hester, and Jane Hruska; two brothers: Charles Berka and Ben Berka; two sons: Jay Berka and Donald Berka; daughter-in-law Betty Berka; grandchildren: Mysti Berka, Dani Bishop, J.J. Bishop, and Nick Hoffman.

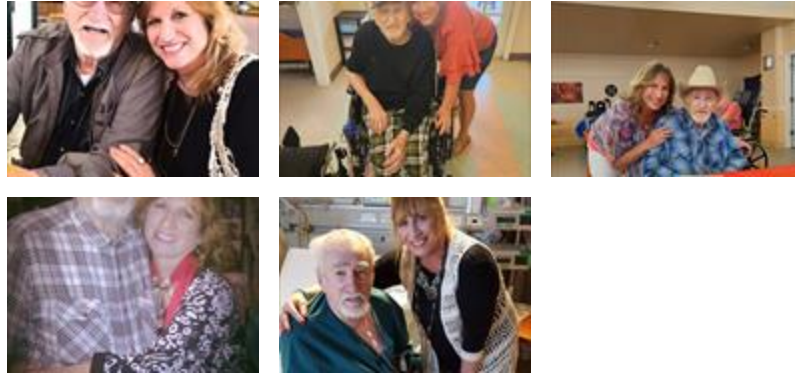
