



## Randell Sheppard Moore

July 21, 1919 - January 19, 2015

Funeral services for Randell Moore, 95 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 22, 2015 at the First Baptist Church in Giddings with Pastor Tim Clayton officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, January 21, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Thursday, January 22, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings.

Randell was born on July 21, 1919 to Seth Sheppard and Ella Lee (York) Moore in Fayette County. He graduated from Giddings High School and was a lifelong learner. He served in the Army during World War II in the European and Pacific Arena and in the Korean War. Mr. Moore was a lifelong member of The First Baptist Church in Giddings where he served as a deacon, taught Sunday school and coordinated weekly services at a local nursing facility. He served as PTA President of the Giddings Public Schools and as a member of the Boy Scout Council. He retired from the Texas Department of Human Services after a lengthy career as a caseworker. His retirement was spent doing the things he loved on his land and telling stories with great detail. The time spent with his grandsons was one of his greatest joys. Mr. Moore died on Monday, January 19, 2015 at Baylor Scott & White in Temple, Texas.

He is survived by his wife of 68 years, Lorene Hempel Moore of Giddings;
