Randy Epps Leech, 60, of Crockett, Texas went to be with our Lord and Savior on Monday, Jan 25th, 2021 at home surrounded by family. He loved our Lord, Jesus Christ, and shared scriptures with others as he knew what being a disciple was all about. He accepted Jesus as his savior and wanted to share the gospel with everyone that he spoke to.

Randy graduated from Rockdale High School in 1979. The highlight of his high school football career was his walking into the playoff game for the first time to replace the injured field goal kicker in a game with 13 seconds left to play hitting a 43-yard field goal giving the Tigers a 9-7 victory that ultimately led them to the State Championship in Irving, Texas where they beat Childress 23-6 in Cowboy Stadium in 1976. After his football career Randy spent countless hours and days roping and tying calves following in the footsteps of his father. As for working and supporting his family Randy could do pretty much anything he put his mind to including surveying, installing glass in high rise buildings, selling electrical supplies and most recently being a landman in the oil and gas industry. Because he was so gifted at making and building relationships, he never met a stranger and always was the first to speak when he went somewhere there were people. Randy calf roped both professionally and at an amateur level for most of his adult life and if you knew anything about Randy, it was that he loved being around horses and the rodeo life.

He met Shellie Prella and they were married in 2011. He and Shellie did everything together and his deep love for her showed in everything they were a part of. They team roped together with Randy heading and Shellie heeling and made an awesome team up until his death. Randy also loved hunting and fishing. Randy took his family on some fun fishing trips numerous times. Many may not know, but he was an amazing cook and could barbeque with the best of them. He loved people and always had a kind heart and words for anyone that knew him. He never forgot anyone he ever met. He felt strongly about loving his family and the togetherness of one. He was selfless to a fault. He built everyone up around him with his positivity.

Randy lived a life full of fun and adventure, which he shared with everyone around him. He was an active member of the AAPL (American Association of Petroleum Landmen). There is not enough room on this sheet of paper to cover all his wonderful adventures. He will be missed beyond measure.

He was preceded in death by his parents Ralph and Sue (Stifflemire) Leech.

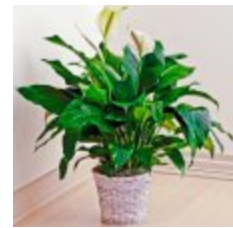
