Ray Dell Hill, 85, of Caldwell passed away Thursday, August 3, 2017 in Bryan. His services are planned for Tuesday, August 8, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. at the Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home Chapel, with Bro. Rick Mitchell officiating. Burial will follow in the Chriesman Cemetery with Military Honors provide by VFW post #4458. The visitation will be held Monday evening from 5:00 to 7:00p.m. at the funeral home.

Ray Dell Hill age 85 years and 11 months, went to be with The Lord on Thursday, August 3rd. He was at the Chi St. Joseph Rehab Facility in Caldwell where he was in rehabilitation following surgery on a broken hip he suffered on June 3. Ray died peacefully in his sleep. He was a kind man who loved his family.

Ray Dell Hill was born September 3, 1931 in Caldwell, Texas to Willis & Ann (Stracener) Hill. He graduated from Caldwell High School in 1952 and joined the U.S. Navy where he served four years including time in the Philippine Islands. After his stint in the Navy he went to work for the Texas Highway Department in Bryan as a chief surveyor in a field party and later as an inspector. In 1981, Ray transferred to the Highway Department's Caldwell office where he worked as the Maintenance Construction Supervisor until his retirement in 1993. After his retirement, they traveled to several states with their camper in-tow. They also went on several bus trips across the United

States and an Alaskan cruise. Ray thoroughly enjoyed his travels across the country. As a younger man he enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping & boating. Ray was a Baptist and a member of Calvary Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents Willis and Ann Hill.

Ray is survived by his wife, Linda Kornegay Hill. They were married 59 years and 10 months.

His sons, Jerry & wife, Candy, Jimmy & wife, Beverly all of Caldwell and a daughter, Debbie & husband, James Moore of Bryan.
