



## Raymond A. Fischer

June 17, 1934 - November 12, 2011

Funeral Services for Raymond A. Fischer are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 15, 2011 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. They were blessed with three children, Sandra, Rodney and Kenneth. He worked in construction/drywall in Houston most of his life and after retiring moved back to Lee County. Raymond enjoyed fishing. Mr. Fischer was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Marvin, Bruce and Billy Ray; brothers-in-law, Milton Beisert and Charlie Myers and son-in-law Lane Lynch. Survivors include his wife, Shirley of Ledbetter; daughter, Sandra (Robinson) Lynch of Houston;

sons Rodney and Rebecca Fischer of Pearland and Kenneth Fischer of Houston; grandchildren, Amanda and Ashley Robinson, of Houston, and Andrew & Bethany Fischer of Rockledge, Florida; sisters, Lillian and Ed Beisert of Houston, Mildred Beisert of Houston and Martha Ann (Judy) Myers of Houston; brother, Jerry Lee & Rosie Fischer of Kansas City, Missouri and several nieces and nephews and many other family and friends.
