Raymond Joe Story, 76 of Rockdale, passed away Wednesday, May 25, 2016 in Temple, Texas. Graveside services will be held at 4:00 pm, Saturday, May 28, 2016 at I.O.O.F. Cemetery in Rockdale with Pastor Ken Ansell officiating. There will be no visitation.

Raymond was born March 23, 1940 to Thomas and Mittie Belle (May) Story in Lovelady, Texas. He married Shirley Ann Rowe on July 9, 1965 at Northshore Church of the Nazarene in Houston, Texas. Raymond was a member of the Rockdale Full Gospel Church. He enjoyed playing golf, watching westerns and he coached girls softball for years. Raymond served as Pastor at The Church of the Nazarene in Rockdale from 1969 to 1972 and worked at the Piggly Wiggly during that time.
