



Richard "Dick" Clay Scott Sr

May 20, 1938 - November 10, 2020

A memorial service for Richard "Dick" Scott Sr., 82 of Dime Box, Texas will be held at 2:00 pm on Sunday, November 15, 2020 at the Giddings Church of Christ with Minister Daryl Parsons officiating.

Richard "Dick" Clay Scott Sr. was born in Shawnee, OK on May 20, 1938 to D.C. and Nell (Burk) Scott. After attending Wewoka public schools for 12 years, where he was a 3-sport athlete during all 4 years of high school, Dick went to Abilene Christian College on a full football scholarship. Dick received his Master's in Education and taught and worked in New Jersey, Texas, New York, and Oklahoma. He even spent a year preaching in a small church in Thyatira, Mississippi. He married Esther Wright on June 2, 1962 at the Beeville Church of Christ in Beeville, Texas and was blessed with three children, Richard Jr., Rhonda, and Roxie. Throughout the years, he served the Lord in many different ways. He volunteered and worked at Camp Shiloh in New Jersey and Camp Hunt in New York, was a song leader, served as an elder and deacon, taught classes, and worked in administration. Dick fondly remembered his time on the football field at Abilene Christian and had a great love of Whataburger and Blue Bell Ice Cream. Over the course of his life he was able to do the things he loved – hunting, reading, studying, gardening, camping, playing with dogs, traveling, singing, running marathons, and coaching football and track. His family always came first and he made time to be involved with all of their activities. Dick also enjoyed spending time with his

many close friends.

Dick passed away the evening of Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at his home in Dime Box.

He is preceded in death by his parents, D.C. and Nell Scott, and one brother, Don Scott.

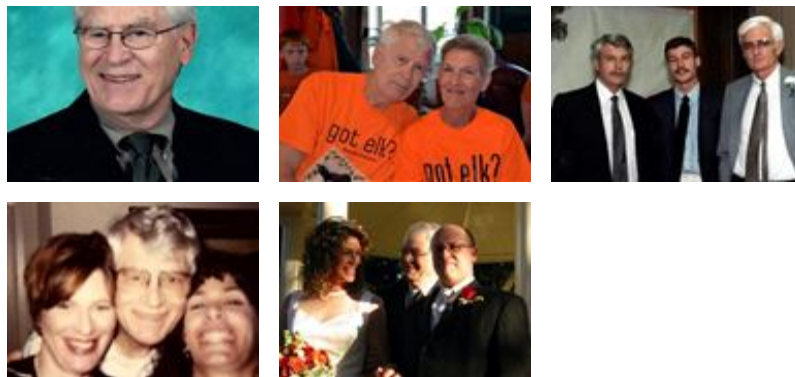
