Richard also owned and operated the Giddings Karate Club for over 40 years. He was a member of the Travis County Regulators shooting club. His family was always his top priority, and he cherished each moment he spent with them.

Richard passed away the afternoon of Thursday, June 30, 2022 in Smithville,

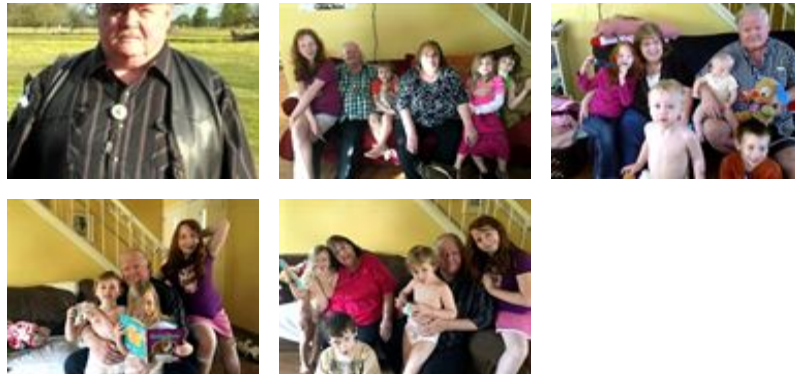

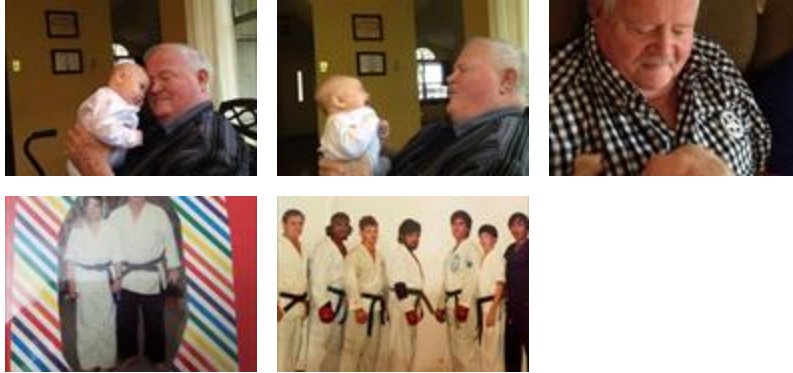
