Richard "Dick" Richardson, 100, of Caldwell passed away peacefully in Caldwell, Texas. A Graveside service is planned for Thursday, September 25, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. at Rest Haven Memorial Park Cemetery in Jacksonville, TX. with Deacon Daniel Allen officiating. Military Honors will be provided by the Honor Guard detail from Ft. Hood, TX.

Dick was born July 17, 1914 in Wright County, Iowa to parents Gregg Richardson and Anna (Loats) Richardson.
