



Richard "Rick" Arvel Reat

February 23, 1946 - December 31, 2019

Richard Arvel Reat was born February 23, 1946 in Shreveport, LA to John H and Dixie (Gowan) Reat. In 1964 Rick graduated from Lexington High school where he lettered in football, basketball and track. He attended Texas A&M in 1964 and 1965 before graduating from Sam Houston State in 1969 with a degree in Ag Education.

On July 29, 1967, he and Geraldine Pogue were married in Lexington, Texas. Rick and Geri lived in Huntsville while he attended Sam Houston and then in other locations where they worked until eventually making their home in Tanglewood, Texas in 1989.

Rick taught Vocational Agriculture in Lexington and Dayton High Schools. He worked for the Texas Department of Corrections as a vocational counselor until his retirement in 2009. He was a long time member of the Lexington United Methodist Church.

Rick was a calf roping and rodeo enthusiast and loved horses. He often reflected on early summers riding around the unpaved streets of Lexington with grade school friends Robert Jenson, Johnny and Barry Parker and cousin John Ashley, also time spent with his roping mentors Bob and Clifton Perry. He enjoyed spending time with his children and grandsons training horses, teaching them roping, other outdoor activities, and watching his grandsons

play high school sports.

Rick passed away Tuesday, December 31, 2019 in Baylor, Scott and White Hospital in Temple, Texas at the age of 73. He was preceded in death by his father, and his grandparents Arvel and Elvira (Stockton) Reat.

Rick is survived by his mother, Dixie Reat of Taylor; his wife of 52 years, Geri Reat of Lexington; his daughter, Dana Barber of Corpus Christi and her children, David Reat and Logan Barber; and his son John Murry "Jody" Reat and wife Marci of Lexington and their children, Corbin Reat and Cason Carter; and his sister Samye Turner and husband Owen of Taylor.

Graveside services will be held at 11:00 A.M. Friday, January 3, 2020, at Lexington Cemetery, with Pastor Casey Goetz officiating. The family will be accepting visitors from 5-7 PM Thursday, January 2, 2020 at Phillips & Luckey in Lexington, Texas.

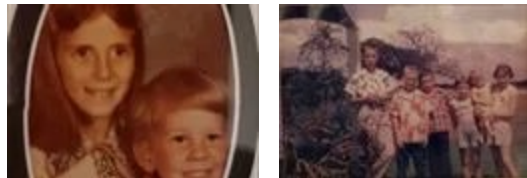

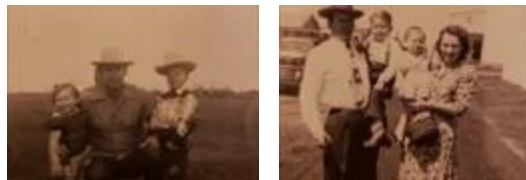
