



Ricky Charles Schueler

Ricky was born on August 14, 1955 to Erwin and Nora (Grimm) Schueler in Brenham, Texas. He was baptized on October 3, 1955 at Messiah Lutheran Church in Houston, Texas by Rev. William Schreiner. Ricky was later confirmed on March 22, 1970 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Emil Krugler.
