



Robert "Bob" Emmitt Baylor

December 24, 1927 - October 12, 2018

Funeral services for Robert "Bob" Baylor, 90, of Huntsville, Texas, are scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 17, 2018 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Lawrence Kelm officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will follow in the St. James Lutheran Cemetery in Lexington, Texas. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, October 17, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Robert Emmitt Baylor was born on December 24, 1927 in San Antonio, Texas to Henry Templeton Baylor and Mary (Shields) Baylor. He was confirmed on July 8, 1951 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in San Antonio by Rev. R. Wiederanders. He served in the United States Navy during World War II and received his Honorable Discharge on December 26, 1947 having obtained the rank of Seaman First Class. Bob was united in marriage to Frances Birnbaum on March 25, 1951 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in San Antonio. Following Frances death on February 7, 1997, Bob married Gertrude (Huber) Farago on May 15, 1998 in Waxahachie, Texas. Gertrude's brother, Rev. Walter Huber, officiated. Bob worked for many years as a flooring installer. He retired from Walmart where he had worked at the stores in Rockdale and Huntsville. While Bob and Frances still lived in Tanglewood, he enjoyed ranching. He also liked

camping and fishing. He and Gertrude enjoyed traveling and went on many trips with the AARP group in Huntsville.

Bob passed away the evening of Friday, October 12, 2018 at his home in Huntsville.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry & Mary Baylor; his wife of nearly 46 years, Frances Baylor; one grandchild, Shannon Baylor; one great grandchild, Cullen Adams; one sister, Courtenay Hardmann and three brothers, John Baylor, Walker Baylor and Hal Baylor.
