



Robert "Bob" Eugene House

November 2, 1939 - August 30, 2018

Funeral services for Robert "Bob" House, 78, of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 3, 2018 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, Texas with Rev. Garrett Smith officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, September 1, 2018 from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m., on Sunday, September 2, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, September 3, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Robert Eugene House was born on November 2, 1939 in Lexington, Texas, the son of Aubrey and Bernice (Bernhardt) House. He was baptized on April 18, 1943 by Rev. Willard Ander and confirmed on June 6, 1954 by Rev. E. Herber at St. John Lutheran Church in Thrall, Texas. Bob graduated from Thrall High School in 1957 and served in the United States Army. He married Lillie Mae Exner on February 13, 1993 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Wilbern Michalk officiating. Many knew Bob also as the "Taylor Meat Man" and was the area salesman for Taylor Meat Company for over 50 years. He enjoyed talking and visiting with everyone he met and Bob never knew any strangers.

Bob passed away during the early morning hours of Thursday, August 30, 2018 at the Giddings Residence and Rehabilitation Center in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Aubrey and Bernice House and a brother-in-law, James Plant.

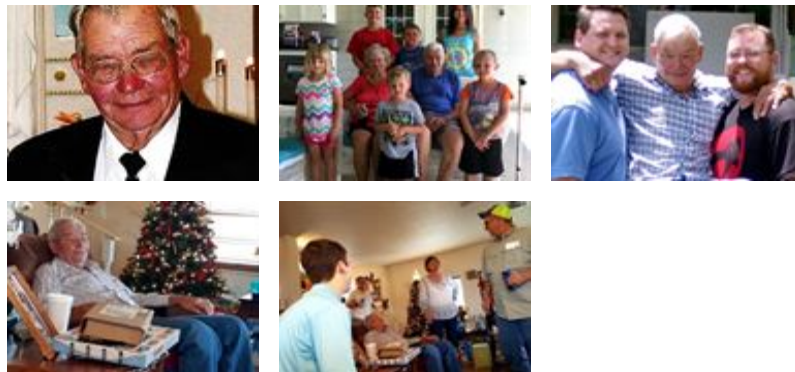
