A memorial service to honor Robert Ludwig will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, August 12, 2016 at the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery, 10100 Horseshoe Bend Rd., Boise, Idaho 83714. Robert will be presented with full military honors at that time.

Robert Wayne Ludwig of San Antonio, Texas was born in Weiser, Idaho on June 22, 1980 to Judy and Scott Ludwig. Robert (also known as Bobby or Bob) grew up in Elgin, Oregon most of his young life and where he attended Elgin High School. During high school, Bob played football, baseball, and wrestled on the wrestling team. He also showed hogs with the local FFA chapter. Robert's achievements in life were numerous, but he will be remembered as a man who loved and is loved.

Robert joined the United States Army at age 17, where he served from 1998 to 2006. During his time with the Army, he was deployed to South Korea for one year and served on the Honor Guard. Robert also served with the Texas National Guard, the Air Force as a medic, and at Fort Sam Houston as an instructor to incoming medics for the past nine years. Robert's time spent serving in the Armed Forces meant a great deal to him as he was proud of his country.
