



Robert Francis "Bobby" Stutes

Funeral services for Robert Stutes, 69 of Lexington, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Friday, March 19, 2021 at Knobbs Springs Baptist Church in Knobbs Springs, Texas with Rev. David Atwood officiating. Committal services, with military honors provided by the Bastrop County Veterans Honor Guard, will immediately follow at the Knobbs Springs Cemetery. Robert "Bobby" Stutes was born on July 28, 1951 in Lake Charles, Louisiana to Raymond and Oney Adell (Mitchell) Stutes. Bobby served in the U.S. Air Force and retired after 20 years of service on October 31, 1992 with the rank of Master Sergeant. While in the Air Force Robert was a computer technician and worked with communication and navigation equipment. He married Rita Diann Surles on March 7, 1998 in Bastrop, Texas at the American Legion Post 233. In his retirement years, he could be found working on his land, hunting, cooking, and barbecuing. Bobby loved watching old westerns and his favorite saying was "With all due respect". He was a member of the American Legion, NRA, several hunting associations, and Knobbs Springs Baptist Church. Bobby was an outgoing person and enjoyed spending time with his family and friends.

Bobby passed away the evening of Saturday, March 13, 2021 at St. David's South Austin Medical Center.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Raymond and Adell Stutes.

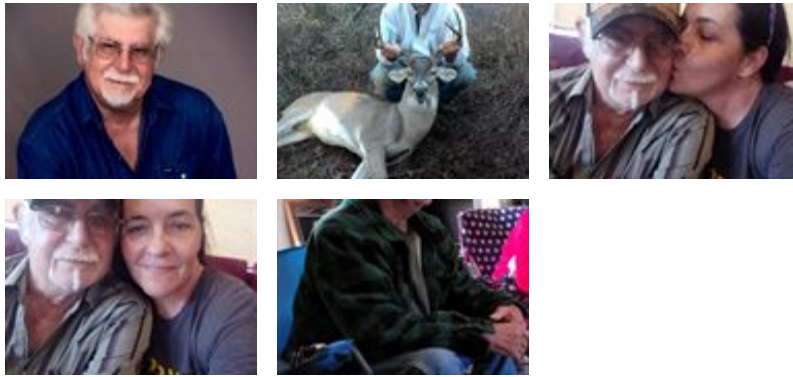
