Robert Kyle Vick, 69, of Caldwell, Texas passed away at his home Wednesday night, July 5, 2023. Graveside services will be held on July 15, 2023 at 9:00 A.M at the Providence Cemetery in Caldwell, Texas.

Robert “Bob” Vick was born in Shreveport, Louisiana, on February 15, 1954. He was the third child of James Edwin and Lanita Vick. Jimmy Jr., Carolyn and Bobby were later joined by a brother, John. The family lived in Louisiana, Mississippi, Arkansas, and Canada, and then he added to his education on a ship called Te Vega.

Bob was able to combine hard work, travel, learning about a variety of cultures, and many skills while also gaining a love for sailing and history. Through the years this afforded him connections to much extended family. He spent some time working on a ranch near Duncan, Oklahoma which is where he met Cindy Thompson. They were married on August 15, 1979 in Lawton, Oklahoma. They made their home in the Caldwell, Texas countryside where they, along with their three daughters, could have horses, cows, and a variety of cats and dogs. Bob told his children he had to walk to school every day and that it was always uphill. He eventually worked for Halliburton until his retirement. He improved their home area and land by continually thinking of creative ideas and improvements. Spelling was not his strong suit which is why he called his wife Cindy his “Spell Chick.” Bob was a loyal son, sibling,

husband, father and grandfather. He had many interests and an endearing sense of humor. He also had radar-like instincts and was very perceptive. Eventually, Thyroid Cancer made it very difficult for him to speak above a whisper. One of his daughters, Katie, said, "Why are you yelling at me?" He replied, "I can't yell." She answered, "You did it with your eyes!"

Bob was preceded in death by his dear wife, Cindy, his grandparents, his father and his younger brother, John.

He is survived by his three daughters Kayla [fiancé Scott Mitschke], Katie, and Kassidy as well as an adoring extended family including his Aunt Jo Anna and Uncle Don Shipe, nieces, nephews, cousins and in-laws.
