



## Rosalie Rosette Hohle

September 2, 1931 - November 6, 2023

On the morning of Monday, November 6, 2023, Rosalie “Rosie” Hohle was welcomed into her Heavenly Home at the age of 92 by her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ along with her beloved family.

Rosalie Rosette Kasper was born as the youngest of 9 children, on September 2, 1931 in Loebau, Texas to Gerhard and Hulda (Moerbe) Kasper. She attended school in Loebau and Dime Box, Texas while working on her family farm, tending to the crops. Rosalie was welcomed to Christ Lutheran Church and was baptized on September 20, 1931 and confirmed on May 20, 1945 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box. As a teenager, outside of church and school, she worked at the Giddings Creamery separating eggs. After Rosie’s brother, Harry, returned from WWII, he returned home to Dime Box, sold his father’s tractor and moved the family to Houston never returning to farming again. A cousin in the family arranged the first meeting of Marvin and Rosalie over dinner at Mathilda and John Hohle’s house in the Heights. They had homemade chicken enchiladas which were raved about for weeks. Shortly afterwards Rosalie married the love of her life at age 19.

Rosalie was united in marriage to Marvin Hohle on August 12, 1950 at St. Mark’s Lutheran Church in Houston, Texas by Rev. Edwin Keiper. Together they raised 3 children in Houston, Texas. In addition to being a dedicated and loving mother, Rosalie worked passionately in her roles for St. Joe’s Paper

Company in Houston, Spring Branch ISD, and the Spring Branch Memorial Hospital. Rosalie and Marvin retired to Giddings in 1990 where they built their home and continued making memories with their family. On August 12, 2000 they celebrated their 50th wedding Anniversary with family and friends throwing a big party. Rosalie was the happiest when her family was gathered together with a Solitaire game in hand. Her enjoyment included drinking an occasional beer, maybe a drink of peppermint schnapps and smoking a cigarette. She enjoyed gardening, working in the flower beds, attending garage and estate sales, fishing in the pond, and being in the kitchen making jelly. She especially loved the time she spent with her sister, Leona, driving the backroads of Lee County. Rosalie will be dearly missed by all who knew her. Rosalie's family asks that she be remembered for the joy she brought to others in life not the sadness of her passing.

Rosalie was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years, Marvin; both her parents, Gerhard and Hulda Kasper; her eight brothers and sisters, Rudy, Monroe and Harry "Happy" Kasper, Gertrude Mitschke, Carrie Reuther, Leona Luecke, and Margaret and Jessele Kasper; her beloved son-in-law, David Hayes; niece, Pearlie Mae Klimicek, and nephews, Eric and E.J. Mitschke.

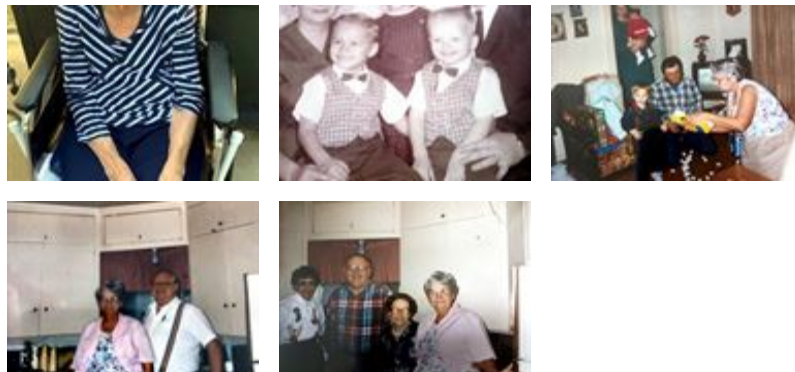
