



Rosalie "Rose" Rek

Rosalie was born October 26, 1925 in Caldwell to Henry and Mary (Mynar) Haisler. She was a 1942 graduate of Caldwell High School and in 1943 a graduate of Durham Business College. On January 13, 1945, she and Jerry R. Rek were married in Caldwell. In 1952 they moved from Fayette County to Rockdale where she and Jerry operated a dairy farm until 1974. She then worked 24 years with NBC Bank, first as a bank teller and then as manager of NBC West Bank. She retired in 1997. She was a member of Peace Lutheran Church in Rockdale, active with Rockdale Senior Citizens Center, a member of New Salem Home Demonstration Club and the Rockdale VFW Ladies Auxiliary.

Rose passed away Thursday morning, February 4, 2016 in the Scott & White Hospital in College Station. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Jerry Rek on November 25, 1986; son, Michael Joe Rek on April 12, 1982; brothers, Anton and Henry Haisler and sister Martha Haisler Ginzel.

Surviving are a sister Lilly Haisler and brother Hubert Haisler of Caldwell; her son Gene Rek and Cindy of Rockdale; daughter-in-law, Jimmie Rek Gillespie of Alabama; five grandchildren, Rhandi Rek Stanford and husband Brian, Jon Rek, Melissa Rek Edwards and husband Michael, Melinda Rek Doolittle and Amanda Rek Garza and husband Matt; 13 great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren and one on the way.

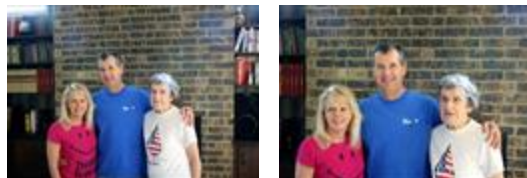
