



Rose Marie Kilian

March 25, 1931 - December 26, 2021

Funeral services for Rose Marie Kilian, 90 of Winchester, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 2, 2022 at St Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester, Texas with Rev. Nate Hill officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Rosine Maria Matthijetz Herzog Kilian was born on March 25, 1931 in Winchester, Texas to Carl August and Anna (Jakobeit) Matthijetz. She was baptized on April 5, 1931 at St. Michael's Lutheran Church by Rev. Erich Moebus and confirmed on March 25, 1945 by Rev. Edward R. Rathgeber. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 27:1, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?". She had her name changed to Rose Marie Matthijetz. Rose was united in marriage to Alwin Paul Herzog on April 3, 1949 at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester by Rev. G. Heinemeier. They moved to Houston and attended Our Redeemer Lutheran Church until Alvin's death in 1970. She then moved to Winchester to take care of her mother who was widowed. She was married to Arnold Theodor "Slim" Kilian on September 22, 1972 at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester by Rev. Adolph Brand. She was a loving and devoted homemaker, mother, grandmother, and great

grandmother. She loved the outdoors and raising chickens and cows. She loved polka music and dancing. Rose's greatest joy in life was spending time with her family and friends.

Mrs. Kilian passed away on December 26th at 10:14 p.m. in Weimer, Texas.
