



Rose Mary Lopez

April 16, 1943 - August 23, 2022

Funeral services for Rose Mary Lopez, 79 of Giddings, will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 2, 2022 at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings with Father Miguel Duarte officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, September 1, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, September 2, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. with a Rosary being recited at 6:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

Rose Mary Lopez was born in Pasadena, Texas on Friday, April 16, 1943, to the parents of Ruperto Zavala Gutierrez and Matiana Rangel Gutierrez at their home delivered by her grandmother, her dad's mom. Rosie as she was later nicknamed was the third oldest of 9 children having 4 sisters and 4 brothers. Rosie grew up in at that time a small city called Pasadena which is located outside of Houston, Texas.

Rosie was a graduate of Pasadena High School class of 1962 and during her education excelled in Art and Homemaking. Having a large family with only her father providing income she had to learn how to work at an early age. Rosie would clean homes, do laundry, ironing, cooking & sewing to help bring income to the home. Little did she know this would be the foundation for the future to come.

Rosie met the love of her life, Jose Lopez, and married on February 10, 1965, starting a family having 2 sons and 1 daughter of their own. Later when tragedy happened in her sister Mary's family, Rosie & Jose quickly stepped in adopting Mary's two children expanding the family to 3 sons & 2 daughters. The family of seven meant Rosie had to become creative in ways to keep her children in line and care for them along with her husband. Together they raised their family in Houston, Texas until moving to Giddings in 1983. Rosie dedicated her life to her family attending to their needs and teaching them how to survive in life.

Rosie had an extraordinarily strong Catholic faith which started as a young girl. The family did not attend church on a regular basis until one was finally built close by, Guardian Angel Catholic Church, where they then attended weekly. This was where she started her religious education, joined the choir, and attended a youth group. This education was the foundation she built on her entire life, instilling in her children, and later becoming a Director of Religious Education after moving to Giddings and joining the Altar Society at St. Margaret's. In her spare time, she would take care of the altar making sure all the cloths were clean, making new ones and even making baptismal bibs. Rosie also was a lector at church and loved helping in every way.

Cooking, dancing, and sewing were her passions, after her children were grown, she took on a job at a local boat factory cutting and sewing patterns for the boat seats. Mom was afraid of the water, never learned how to swim even after a couple of years in swimming class in high school. She did not mind making the seats for the boats, because she knew she would never try them out. Later she took a job as a cook at the local high school and quickly made her way up to head cook. The students ate well those years, and the staff also loved her cooking. Rosie also volunteered at the Rejuvenation Thrift Store in Giddings once a month to help provide an inexpensive place for people to

shop.

Gatherings at the home were always in the kitchen at the big round table with the lazy Suzan in the middle full of delicious food. It was an honor for her to teach her children and grandchildren how to cook, but even more rewarding for her to see you eat, get full and then bring out the desserts. If you ever left hungry it was your own fault, not from the lack of her offering to feed you. She was a perfectionist in the kitchen always tweaking the recipe, so what you thought was delicious next time would be delicioso!

Rosie retired early from the school to attend to her husband Jose when he became ill. She was his caretaker for the last ten years of his life and was devastated with his death. She too became ill with cancer and then later with dementia, having a fall breaking her wrist made 24 hour care a necessity. She then resided at a local nursing home & was there until she had a stroke spiraling her health downward. The final care came from her children taking turns around the clock tending to her every need. She left this world surrounded by her children, their spouses, grandchildren, their spouses, great grandchildren, friends, neighbors all singing the "Divine Mercy" with nothing but love. Tears of sorrow and joy were expressed as she headed to her destination to meet her maker, rejoin her husband Jose and all the family who have gone before her.

Rosie is preceded in death by her parents Ruperto & Matiana Gutierrez, her sister Mary Gutierrez, her brother Jesse Gutierrez, her brother-in-law Gary Chauvin, her sister Georgia Gonzalez, her brother-in-law Daniel Gonzalez, her nephew Gilbert Gonzalez, her sister-in-law Lupe Gutierrez, her great grandchild Perpetua Grace Lopez, her husband Jose Lopez.

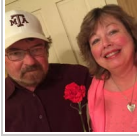
