



## Roseann Heck Dorsett

March 31, 1925 - October 4, 2016

Memorial services for Roseann Heck Dorsett, 91, of Giddings and formerly of Houston, will be held at a later date at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Herbert Keistman officiating. A private family burial will be held in the Giddings City Cemetery.

Roseann Heck Dorsett was born on March 31, 1925 in Burton, Texas to Milton "M.G." Garrett Heck Sr. and Stella Margaret (Homeyer) Heck. She was united in marriage to Richard H. "Dick" Dorsett on January 13, 1946. Their union was blessed with two children, Rebecca and Richard. Roseann received a double major in music from Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas. She went on to sing with a trio in Austin at KLBJ Radio for several years. She also sang in the choir at the First United Methodist Church in Giddings, the Tuesday Music Club and the Junior League in Houston. She joined the USO and sang for service members during WWII. Roseann taught at a private school in Little Rock, Arkansas and later was a substitute teacher for the Houston Independent School District. Roseann enjoyed traveling, going to see theatrical performances and spending time with her grandchildren. She also volunteered at MD Anderson in Houston and served with the Women's League of Voters. After 43 wonderful years of marriage, Dick passed away in 1984. Several years later she met and married Larry Wilson who preceded her in death after two years of marriage. Roseann's faith in Christ was the cornerstone of her life.

Roseann passed away the morning of Tuesday, October 4, 2016 at St. Mark's

Medical Center in La Grange.

She was preceded in death by her parents, M.G. Heck Sr. and Stella Heck; both of her husbands, Richard "Dick" Dorsett and Larry Wilson; one sister, Nina McVey and one brother Milton Garrett Heck Jr.
