Roy Oscar Hengst, 93, of Thorndale, passed away Saturday, April 4, 2015 at his residence. Funeral services are set for 2:00 pm, Wednesday, April 8, 2015 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Thorndale with Pastor Scott Schaller officiating.
