



Roy Albert Medack

November 8, 1944 - September 15, 2021

Funeral services for Roy Medack, 76 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 19, 2021 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings, with Rev. Robert Tiner and Vicar Josh Hahn officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, September 18, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, September 19, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Medack family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Roy Albert Medack was born on November 8, 1944 in Giddings, Texas, the second of two children born to Albert John August Medack and Louise Gesine Anna (Namken) Medack. He was baptized at home on November 19, 1944 by Rev. Paul G. Brust and was confirmed on March 22, 1959 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann. His confirmation verse was Revelation 2:10, "Be though faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life." He attended Immanuel Lutheran School in Giddings and graduated from Giddings High School in 1963. On June 11, 1966, Roy was united in marriage to Ruth Agnes Lehmann at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester, Texas with Rev. R.M. Frieling officiating. They were blessed with two daughters, Sheila and Suzanne. After their marriage, Roy and Ruth were members at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester where they served as youth counselors. Later, they transferred their membership to

Immanuel Lutheran Church where Roy served as an usher for many years. He began working at Gruetzner's Furniture while still in high school before going to work at Orsag's and then Faske Electric. He then went to work at the Giddings State School beginning as a houseparent and retiring as an electrician in the maintenance department in 1998 after 26 years. Roy enjoyed spending time outdoors, farming, raising cattle, hunting and fishing. He and Ruth always tended to a large garden, and Roy kept pristine care of their beautiful yard. Many times he could be found sitting on the front steps watching cars drive by and keeping his eye on the weather. He especially enjoyed watching thunderstorms roll in. As much as he enjoyed being outdoors, usually in the afternoons he could be found sitting in his chair watching old westerns. He always looked forward to the times he spent with his family, especially the grandchildren.

Roy passed away during the early morning hours of Wednesday, September 15, 2021, surrounded by love, at his home in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Albert & Louise Medack; his parents-in-law, Walter & Louise Lehmann; two brothers-in-law, Henry Umscheid and Terry Key and one sister-in-law, Janis Lehmann.

Roy is survived by his wife of 55 years, Ruth Medack of Giddings; two daughters, Sheila Fox of Austin and Susie Stewart & her husband, Peter of Midland, Texas; four grandchildren, Shaunn Quayle & her husband, Steve of Austin and Jack, Hannah & Nicklaus Stewart of Midland; one great granddaughter, Amelia Stewart-Bolieu of Spokane, WA; one sister, Gladys Umscheid of Austin; one sister-in-law, Elaine Key of League City; one brother-in-law, Maclyn Lehmann of Winchester; three aunts, Gladys Namken of Giddings, Janet Namken of Giddings, and Frances Medack of Giddings, as well as many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

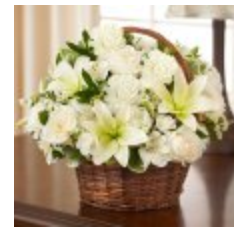
