



Rubie Irene Galipp

November 6, 1926 - May 3, 2018

Funeral services for Rubie Galipp, 91, of Ledbetter, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 7, 2018 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, May 6, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, May 7, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Rubie Irene (Proske) Galipp was born on November 6, 1926 in Lincoln, Texas, the daughter of Ernest August Proske and Otilie Alma (Krause) Proske. She was baptized on November 21, 1926 and confirmed on April 6, 1941 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln by Rev. Reinhard Osthoff. Her confirmation verse was Pslam 37:5, "Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass". Rubie was united in marriage to Herman John Galipp on June 20, 1948 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Houston, Texas by Rev. Oliver Harms. She worked for Nabisco in Houston for many years and was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings. Rubie enjoyed quilting and taking care of her flowers. She and Herman spent many hours together working in their garden and taking care of their cattle.

Rubie passed away the morning of Thursday, May 3, 2018 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband of 62 years, Herman Galipp; four brothers, Carl Proske, Alfred Proske, Ewald Proske and Gilbert Proske and six sisters, Meta Smithberry, Matilda Foerster, Maria Kramer, Betty Gollar, Gussie Walker and Lillie Ruab.

Rubie is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Peggy & Robert Coil of Round Top; her granddaughter, Heather Parker of Bastrop; her great granddaughter, Abigail "Abbie" Parker of Bastrop; her sister, Judy Stogsdill of Beasley; her sister-in-law, Clara Proske of Houston as well as several nieces and nephews.
