



Ruth Bernice Beisert

November 24, 1934 - March 15, 2025

Ruth Bernice (Schulze) Beisert was born on November 24, 1934, in Loebau, Texas, the daughter of Gustav and Theodora (Iselt) Schulze. She passed away during the early evening hours on Saturday, March 15, 2025, at Oakland Manor Nursing Center, at the age of 90.

Funeral services are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 22, 2025 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, Texas, with Rev. David Mumm officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, March 21, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., and 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 22, 2025 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Ruth was baptized on December 9, 1934, at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. WM. H. Remmert, and confirmed on March 21, 1948, at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. Herbert Hartfield. Her confirmation verse was 2 Peter 3:18 (KJV), "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever." She married the love of her life, Alvin Beisert, on January 13, 1952, at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, Texas. Ruth and Alvin spent the early years of their life together in Seattle, Washington, while Alvin was serving in the Marines. Ruth and Alvin were blessed with two sons, Michael and Ronnie. They moved then to

Houston, Texas, and then finally in the late 1960s moved back to the old Beisert homestead in Loebau, Texas.

Ruth spent over 50 years working alongside her husband and sons running the day-to-day operations of their family business, Alvin Beisert & Sons Drywall, first in Houston, Texas, and then in Giddings, Texas. She was meticulous in her bookkeeping and often shared her office with her grandchildren during the summers, teaching them her trade. When not working, Ruth enjoyed spending time on her back porch with family and friends, hosting fish fries, camping, gardening, ranching, canning, cooking, and making noodles and homemade jelly. They also enjoyed taking family and friends on trips in their Winnebago. She loved listening and dancing to polka music, and in the early years she would travel with her husband and their family band to local dancehalls. She cherished the time she was able to spend with her family and extra-large extended family, especially hosting Thanksgiving dinners, Christmas celebrations, and Easter egg hunts for her grandchildren and great-grandchildren whom she adored.

Ruth was a member of Christ Lutheran Church, where she enjoyed many church activities, including the annual Fall Turkey Dinner, Ladies Aid, and the annual Mother's Day Picnic. She also enjoyed working as a volunteer at the Giddings Braille Center. Ruth loved the Lord and wasn't shy about making it known when you weren't conducting yourself in accordance with His Word. She loved singing hymns in English and German and teaching her grandchildren all that she knew about His love.
