RUTH E. PAUL, 85, of Caldwell passed away Saturday, December 8, 2012 in Bryan. She worked Vacation Bible Schools; she created flower arrangements for the church out of her garden. When she wasn't working she enjoyed gardening, quilting, listening to music, dancing and humming. She loved to laugh and had a wonderful sense of humor.
