Graveside services for Sam H. 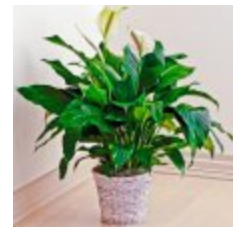

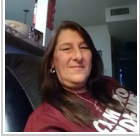
