Sammy Dale Patton was born on November 3, 1947 in Terral, Oklahoma, the son of Leonard and Voncile (Dean) Patton. He enlisted in the United States Army on July 10, 1965 and was discharged on July 9, 1971. On April 11, 1994 he married Susette Clough in Andrews, Texas. He worked as a truck driver for Key Energy for many years and most recently drove for Altman Plants in Giddings.
