Sara Ann Myers-Worrell was born to the late Eddie Mae Maloy-Myers and Bobby Ray Myers Sr. in Rockdale, Texas on November 16, 1960. She resided in Milano, Texas for the majority of her teenage and young adult years, prior to moving to the Griffin Chapel Community. She graduated from Milano High School in May of 1978, and went on to attend Temple Junior College in Temple, Texas. On November 19, 2014, she was united in Holy Matrimony to William Worrell, her long life love, whom she reconnected with after many years.

She accepted Christ at an early age at Goodwill Baptist Church in Milano, Texas where she was an active member. She served as the Sunday school Secretary and substitute teacher for the primary Sunday school class, and she was active in the choir and served on the church food/program committee, and the youth ministry.

She held many professional positions working at Milano Independent School District and Alcoa Alumni Plant in Rockdale, Texas, and as a Chief for several local restaurants, but her most valuable position was serving as a homemaker and mother to her children and grandchildren, whom she loved more than anything. Her family was everything to her, and her grandchildren were the

center of her world. She enjoyed cooking for her family and friends and hosting family events at her home. She loved to help anyone in need, serving as a Foster Mother for the State of Texas, providing a stable home for displaced children, and serving on the Milano City Council as part of the Mayor Pro-Tempore team in the early and late 90's, and as the Park and Recreational Planner. She was instrumental in helping to raise grant funds for housing for the elderly, and coordinating the city park holiday parties for the children in the Milano community. Sara never met a stranger. She was always kind and giving. She touched the hearts of everyone she came in contact with.

She was preceded in death by her Mother Eddie Mae Maloy –Myers on May 13, 2017, her father Bobby Ray Myers Sr. on December 19, 1978, and a brother Bobby Ray Myers Jr on April 29, 1985, and her maternal grandparents Minnie Mack in 1999, Eddie Maloy in 1993, and paternal grandparents Eugene Myers in 1962, and Alder Clay Myers 1975.

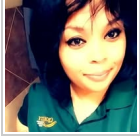
