Scott Juel Randall, 67 of Rockdale, passed away on April 4, 2021. A graveside service will be 11 am, Saturday, April 10, 2021, at I.O.O.F. Cemetery with Pastor Gary Veit officiating. The family will receive visitors, Friday, April 9, from 6-8 pm at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale, Texas.
