



Sean Blaine Matejcek

March 30, 1975 - May 6, 2018

Funeral services for Sean Matejcek, 43, of Leo, Indiana and formerly of Giddings, are scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on Friday, May 11, 2018 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, May 10, 2018 from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. with the family being present from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Sean Blaine Matejcek was born on March 30, 1975 in Houston, Texas to Robert Dale Matejcek and Terry Renee (Pampell) Matejcek. He was baptized on April 20, 1975 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Fred Mgebhoff. Sean was confirmed on March 19, 1989 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Wilburn Michalk and Rev. Robert Koenig. His confirmation verse was John 8:31-32, "If you hold to my teaching, you are truly my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free". Sean graduated from Giddings High School in 1993 and attended Blinn College in Brenham. He was a shop foreman and a CNC programmer at American Industrial Polymers in Giddings for several years. He was currently employed at Wayne Metals in Fort Wayne, Indiana, where he was a team leader and programmer in the CNC Lathe Department. Sean was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings and had served on the Board of Christian Day School at Immanuel Lutheran School. He had been a member of the Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department and served on the board of the

Lincoln Community Center. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, baling hay, working on tractors and farm equipment. His greatest joy was his children, Sara and Seth.

Sean passed away unexpectedly the evening of Sunday, May 6, 2018 at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Joe & Antonia Matejcek and Albert & Juanita "Mickey" Pampell and his aunts and uncles, Alice Lynch, Betty Pampell, Belinda "B.J." Pampell, Timothy Pampell, Rebecca Stone and Robert Spitzenberger.
