



Sebrina "Rina" Ann Feuerlein

January 5, 1977 - September 20, 2022

A funeral mass for Sebrina "Rina" Feuerlein, 45 of San Antonio, Texas, is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Monday, September 26, 2022 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Dime Box, Texas with Father George Joseph officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

Sebrina Ann (Mikulin) Feuerlein was born on January 5, 1977 in Giddings, Texas, the daughter of John David Mikulin and Margaret Ann (Goertz) Mikulin. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Dime Box. After graduating from Dime Box High School in 1994, Sebrina attended the Brenham Beauty School and graduated in 1996. She was a longtime hair stylist at Supercuts in Bastrop. She married David Feuerlein on February 25, 2006 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Rockne, Texas. Sebrina was a creative and talented individual who enjoyed arts and crafts and was constantly decorating and updating her family's house to make it more of a home. She enjoyed bible studies and growing in her faith. She was the ultimate animal lover and often took in and cared for strays.

Sebrina passed away suddenly the afternoon of Tuesday, September 20, 2022 at her home in San Antonio.

She was preceded in death by her grandparents, Martin and Irene Goertz and John and Laura Mikulin.

Sebrina is survived by her husband, David Feuerlein of San Antonio; her three sons, Randall Andrejczak of San Antonio, Nathan Feuerlein and Samira Murica of San Antonio, and Jacob Feuerlein and Chloe Simmons of San Antonio; her parents, John David and Margaret Mikulin of Dime Box; one brother, John Mikulin III and his wife, Kelly of Red Rock and their children, Cory and Brody; one sister, Crystal Hammons and her husband, Cole of Rosanky and their children, Sophie, Millie, Annie, Fransie, and Josie; two brothers-in-law, Michael Feuerlein and his wife, Gilda of San Antonio and Kurt Feuerlein of San Antonio as well as several aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
