She enjoyed fishing and watching Wheel of Fortune and the Price is Right and would get just as excited as the contestants did. Sharon loved all animals and enjoyed feeding and taking care

of her dogs, cats, chickens, and cattle and especially the baby calves. Her favorite days were her birthday and Christmas because she would get to open up presents.

Sharon passed away on Monday, September 21, 2020 surrounded by her family at her home in Fedor.

She was preceded in death by her father, Randolph Woelfel.

Sharon is survived by her mother, Marilyn Woelfel of Fedor; her brother and sister-in-law, Ronald and Vickie Woelfel of Lexington; her sister and brother-in-law, Diane and Marvin Stromberg of Taylor, as well as multiple nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.

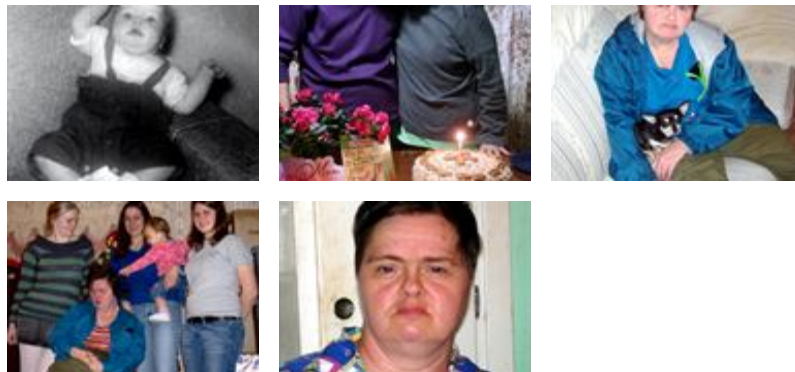
