



Shelley Brown Huettel

November 18, 1945 - September 13, 2023

Funeral services for Shelley Brown Huettel, 77 of Lexington, will be held 2:00 p.m. Sunday, September 24, 2023 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Rev. Marsha Brown officiating. It will be preceded by a visitation from 1:00-2:00pm and followed by a graveside ceremony in the Hugh Wilson Cemetery in Tanglewood.

Shelley was born November 18, 1945, in Houston to Oscar and Frances Brown. She moved with her family to Rockdale, where she graduated from Rockdale High School, and then returned to Houston, where she graduated from the University of Houston. She and Robert Huettel were married June 17, 1966 in Houston.

After living in the San Antonio area during Robert's military service, they returned to the Houston area and settled in Deer Park, where Shelley raised three children and volunteered for a wide range of activities. She was particularly engaged with Scouting, serving as a leader within local packs and troops, summer camps, and the Sam Houston area council. She later worked as a Data Analyst for Solvay / INEOS until her retirement.

Shelley and Robert moved to Lexington in 2007, building a house on her father's cattle ranch and raising cattle of their own. She was an active member of the local community, and particularly committed to the Lexington Log Cabins, for which she was a volunteer and board member.

She passed away Wednesday, September 13, 2023 in the Baylor Scott & White Hospital in Round Rock. She was preceded in death by Robert, her parents, mother- and father-in-law, Metha and John Huettel, and her siblings Bernice Brown Francis, Conrad Brown, Donald Brown, Joyce Brown, Margaret Brown Hooper, Odell Brown, and Rodney Brown.

Surviving are her two sons, Scott Huettel and wife Lisa of Chapel Hill, North Carolina, and Eric Huettel of Lexington; her daughter, Holly Huettel of Giddings; her brother, Mark Brown; two grandchildren, Elissa Huettel and Nicholas Huettel; and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

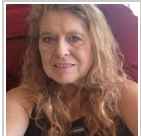
