A celebration of life for Sherry Dawn Owens, 62 of Lexington, Texas will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, December 10, 2021 at Lexington United Methodist Church with Rev. Raegan Seaton officiating.

Sherry passed away unexpectedly the afternoon of Monday, August 9, 2021 at her home in Lexington.

Sherry Dawn Owens was born on December 10, 1958 in Giddings, Texas to Kermit and Billie Ann (Fricke) Langehennig. She was baptized on July 12, 1959 by Rev. David Early and confirmed on April 12, 1981 at Lexington United Methodist Church. Sherry graduated in 1979 from Blinn College in Brenham with an Associate's degree in Business Management. On October 12, 1991, Sherry married Marcus Owens on the square in Lexington. Their marriage was blessed with four children. Sherry and Marcus purchased Lexington Auto Repair in October 1996. They were active members of the Lexington EMS and Lexington Volunteer Fire Department. 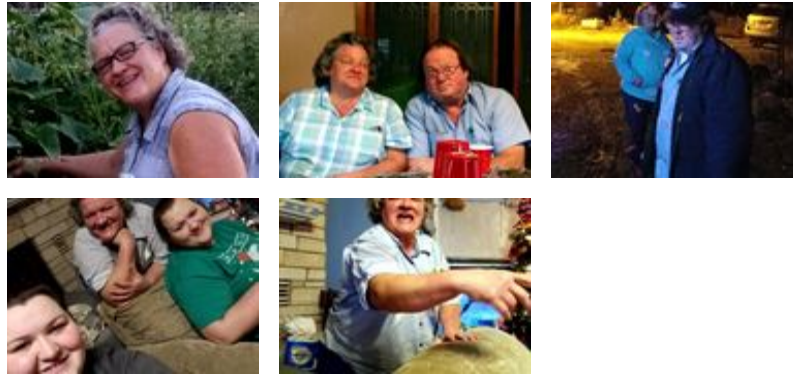
