Shirley was born into the loving arms of Eddie Joe Cooper and Arvilla June Cooper-Flow (nee Cheak) on January 25, 1956 in Slaton, Texas. She went into the open arms of Jesus on January 18, 2018. Shirley passed in her home with her beloved husband, Doug Davenport, by her side.

Shirley grew up in Lamesa, Texas with her sister and brothers as some of her best friends. She was the studious one of the family and often talked about how her father expected her to make good grades. While in high school, she was an active member of Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA). Shirley made lifelong best friends in Lamesa, whom she still loves. Years after graduating high school, she and her sister looked forward to the Jubilee Days and visiting their friends.

Shirley married James "Jimmie" Davenport in 1976 and the two were together thirteen years. They welcomed in their pride and joy, Summer June and James Michael, into their family. If you knew Shirley, you know she loved to brag on her children. She would make them special birthday cakes, have

beautiful homecoming mums and garters for them, take them on their favorite staycations in Austin, go out of her way to make Christmases and birthdays memorable, celebrate all their accomplishments, treat their friends as her own children, make slumber parties fun for the girls and boys, encourage their education, and was their biggest fan. The most significant impact Shirley had on her children was introducing them to Jesus Christ. She encouraged Summer and Michael in their faith, as hers was unwavering.

In the 1980s, Shirley went to college and became an LVN, then an RN. She primarily worked in long term care. Shirley became the Director of Nurses for a few nursing homes and took pride in caring for her residents and staff. Her professional calling was a tremendous act of service to others.

In the mid-2000s, Shirley reconnected with her teenage heartthrob, Douglas "Doug" Davenport. Almost immediately, the two were inseparable. They enjoyed making trips to San Antonio; spending time with their children and grandchildren; making renovations to their home, which they named The Rockin' D Ranch; and listening to classic rock and country and western music. Shirley and Doug shared a strong love for one another that was evident to anyone who knew them.

Shirley met the absolute love of her life in 2016 when her granddaughter, Adeline Paige Davenport, was born. She was ecstatic to be Addie's Mimi. Shirley loved doting on her and wanted to have a present for Addie each time they visited. Mimi's love for Addie is unending and is with her even now.

To know Shirley was to love her laugh and smile. If you could make her laugh, she loved you. Her family and close friends were her lifelines. Shirley enjoyed spending time with her maternal family in the Slaton area and paternal family in the Rockdale area. She loved her grandparents, aunts, and uncles dearly. Many good times and much laughter was shared with her cousins. She would

do anything for her sister and brothers. Of course, Shirley's mother was her heart.

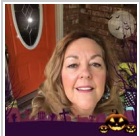

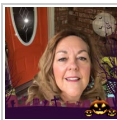

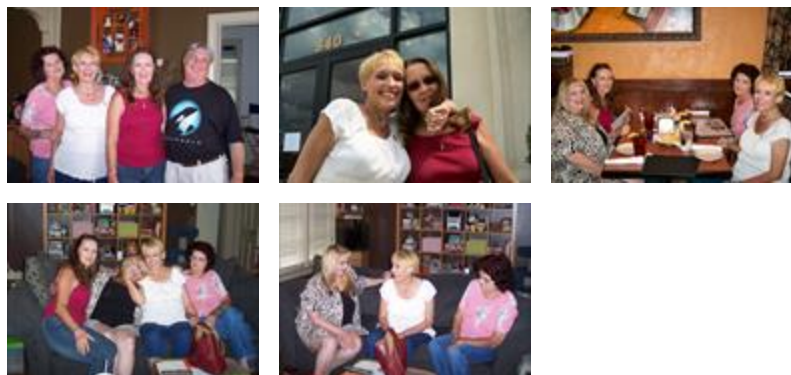
