Shirley Louise Holton Lane, age 74 of Rockdale, passed away Wednesday afternoon, March 22, 2017 in St. David's Hospital in Georgetown.

Funeral services are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. Monday, March 27, 2017 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale, with Matt Higginbotham of First Baptist Church officiating and there will be an Eastern Star ceremony.
