



Sophie Blandina Pampell

July 11, 1931 - January 24, 2021

Graveside services for Sophie Pampell, 89 of Giddings, Texas will be held at 2:00 pm on Sunday, January 31, 2021 at Old Holy Cross Lutheran Cemetery in Warda with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Visitation will be held on Saturday, January 30, 2021 from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm and on Sunday, January 31, 2021 from 9:00 am to noon at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present Saturday evening from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Sophie Blandina Pampell was born on July 11, 1931 in Northrup, Texas to John T. "Johnnie" and Marie Louise (Mertink) Mitschke. She was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin on July 19, 1931 and confirmed at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda on March 23, 1945. Her confirmation verse was John 11:25-26, "Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die." Sophie married Marvin L. Pampell on January 16, 1953 in Houston, Texas. In her early days, she worked at the Rice Hotel in Houston. After she and Marvin moved back to Giddings in 1968, she worked part time for a couple of years in the lunchroom at Immanuel Lutheran School. She was primarily a housewife that loved to cook, can vegetables, and do embroidery work.

Sophie passed away the morning of Sunday, January 24, 2021 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings where she had been a resident for four

years.

She is preceded in death by her parents, John T. and Marie Louise Mitschke; sister and brother-in-law, Hildegard and Alfred Krause; brother and sister-in-law, Vestin and Alma Mitschke, and brother-in-law, Herbert Schautschick.
