



Susan Diane Jatzlau

Susan Diane Jatzlau was born on September 9, 1961 in Giddings, Texas to Edwin "Jack" Charles Jatzlau Jr. and Vallie Jean (Weyand) Jatzlau. She was baptized on October 15, 1961 at Immanuel Lutheran Church by Rev. Max Studtmann and was confirmed on March 23, 1975 also at Immanuel Lutheran Church by Rev. Emil Krugler. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 46:1, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." She graduated from Giddings High School with the class of 1979. While in high school, Susan worked at The Jewel Box and Central Freight. After graduation, she went to work for the Clayton Williams office in Giddings. In 1989, she moved to Austin where she went to work for American Tile. Susan moved back to Giddings in 2008 and was employed in the accounting department at The Nitsche Group. Susan was a lifelong member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings and a supporter of the ASPCA. She preferred to live a quiet life and could sometimes be considered a private person. She enjoyed taking care of her plants and was a creative individual who enjoyed working on craft projects that she often gave to others. She liked to travel and take vacations with her

family and tour model homes to get interior design ideas. An accomplished photographer, she found the beauty in the most basic of objects.

Susan passed away early the morning of Wednesday, December 16, 2020, surrounded by her family, in Giddings following a fiercely fought battle with cancer.

She is preceded in death by her father, Edwin “Jack” Jatzlau Jr.; grandparents, Edwin Jatzlau Sr., Adele Jatzlau Krauss, Carlie Krauss, and Jesse & Otilie “Tillie” Weyand, and two uncles, Louis “Dick” Weiss, and Lee Roy “Sonny” Fricke.
