Tamshaw Cindy Cavaliere Becker was born on March 21, 1953 in San Antonio, Texas, the daughter of Clayton and Mildred (Doughty) Collins. She was baptized on February 5, 1980 and confirmed on October 28, 2002 at Redeemer Lutheran Church in Austin. She graduated from John H. Reagan High School and attended Nixon Clay College. Tamshaw was united in marriage to Wayne Becker on June 5, 1999 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Paul Hartfield. She worked as a caregiver for over 30 years. Tamshaw was a member of ADAPT of Texas and lobbied to enhance the rights and services of people with disabilities. She enjoyed watching baseball games, trips to the beach, arts and crafts, and listening to her son Dylan play music with the various bands he was a member. An avid gardener, she spent many hours working in her flowerbeds and garden even having her yard being selected as the "Yard of the Month" by the area garden club.

Tamshaw passed away suddenly the morning of Tuesday, December 13, 2022 at her home in Round Rock.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Clayton and Sylvia Collins and Mildred and Lonnie Bullock; one sister, Ann Woodley, and two brothers, Jimmy Collins and Rick Collins.

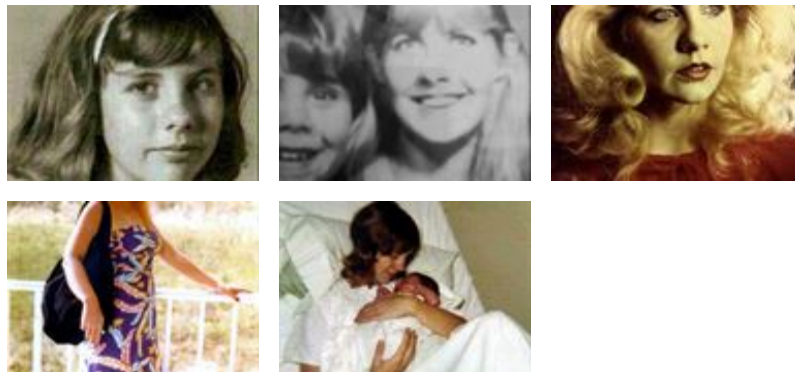
