Terry Alan Ausley, 72, owner of Ausley Dozer Service in Caldwell passed away unexpectedly on April 25, 2024 in Colorado Springs, Colorado after a short illness. A Celebration of Terry's Life will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, June 10, 2024 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell.

Terry graduated from Lee High School in 1970. Later that year he married the love of his life, Linda Gayle Mullins. Terry attended Lee JR College, studying police administration. Much of his business was dedicated to serving local businesses, ranches and oil production operations. Terry enjoyed hunting and wheeling with his family. He was hard working, dedicated and a loyal friend, to all who knew him. He will be dearly missed, and never forgotten.

Terry is preceded in death by his parents and his wife Linda.

He is survived by his two sons, David and his wife, Emma and Devin Ausley;

daughter Lisa and her husband Bryan Allen as well as many nieces and nephews.

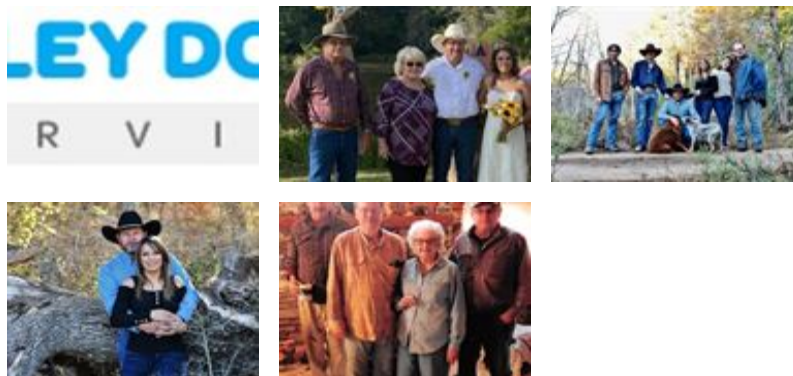
