February 2, 1957 - February 12, 2021

Thomas Walter (Tommy) McCoy passed away unexpectedly at his home on Friday, February 12, 2021. Due to the weather the following changes were made; Visitation will be held on Friday, February 19th from 1-2 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with services to follow at 2 p.m. with Eric Garcia officiating. A private family graveside will be held at a later date.

Tommy, born on February 2, 1957 was the oldest of 5 children born to Helen Joyce (Stolte) and James Herschel McCoy. He graduated from Thorndale High School in 1975 and started his career @ ALCOA in Rockdale that same year.

Tommy never met a stranger, but if he did cross paths with someone he had not previously met, he would strike up a conversation and find common interests for a discussion. Everyone who knew Tommy appreciated his quick wit and his ability to tell jokes.

Tommy and Denise (Lange) were blessed with 43 years together, having married on February 11, 1978. Camping, fishing, hunting and the love of sports, especially everything involving Thorndale Bulldogs and Texas Longhorns were always a part of Tommy's conversations. No matter when you drove down Wuensche St., you would always see extra cars at the McCoy's... after Friday night Bulldog football games, on Saturday afternoons or even week day evenings after work. The McCoy's house made everyone

comfortable enough to just sit on the patio, relax and talk...about anything & everything with Tommy.

Tommy and Denise built their lives together in Thorndale where they raised their 2 children, Kyle and Morgan (McCoy) Nadeau. Having a large family to/for support, along with a wealth of friends for all sorts of gatherings from Christmas and Easter Celebrations to Squirrel Fest, demonstrated the love that Tommy had for others and they for him.

Tommy was a life-long member of the Pleasant Retreat Methodist Church. He retired in 2018 from Luminant where he worked as an electrician.

Tommy is survived by his wife, Denise and children Kyle McCoy & Morgan (Doug) Nadeau. He was blessed to be called Opa by Kannon McCoy & Chase Nadeau. His "Opa" status extended, as well, to Mackenzie and Camden Foley, daughters of Crystal Foley. He adopted the name "Grandpa" from Morgan's bonus daughters Cari Garcia, Kirsten & Chelsea Nadeau. In addition, Tommy is survived by his dad, Herschel, his brothers, James (Vanissa) and Kevin (Karen), a sister, Kim (Bill) Jordan, sister-in-law, Jackie McCoy, his brother-in-law, Rupert (Karen) Lange, sister-in-law-Amanda (Terry) Tackett, aunts, Barbara (Red) Smith and Judy Jordan.
