She had attended church at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas where she also

taught Sunday school. Most recently, she helped to organize and attended the Paige Home Church of God. Vernie passed away the afternoon of Saturday, October 19, 2019 at her home in Paige.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Louis & Alma Woelfel; her daughter, Mary Ann Arldt; her grandson, Justin Arldt; three brothers and four sisters.
